CHATEAU-GRILLET

Château-Grillet has a rich history, illustrating perfectly the passion and devotion of many generations of men and women for this exceptional terroir.

The Viognier grape reigns supreme here, giving birth to wines of great intensity, tension and minerality: Château-Grillet and Côtes-du-Rhône.

The 3.5-hectare vineyard is situated in a south-facing amphitheatre with well-trained soil offering ideal conditions for the production of great wines and the friable sub-soil allows the vine's roots to dig deep to draw on water and mineral elements.

Domaine d'Eugénie

It is located in Vosne-Romanée, in the heart of the Côte-de-Nuits between Nuits-Saint-Georges and Gevrey-Chambertin.

Clos de Tart

Clos de Tart was created in 1141 by the Tart Abbey Bernardine sisters, a branch of the nearby Cistercian congregation before passing into the hands of the Marey-Mange family in 1791. It was granted Grand Cru classification in 1939.

The magnificent vineyard represents a single plot of land covering 7.53 hectares, the largest Grand Cru monopole in Burgundy, located on the Morey-Saint-Denis terroir in the Côte de Nuits.

An ancient stone wall surrounds the vineyard which has remained intact since its creation in the 15th-century and encompasses vines which are 60 years old on average, planted on rich limestone and clay soil.

Grapes are meticulously harvested by hand and vinified in six separate lots with wines matured in 100% new oak and bottled unfiltered producing a Grand Cru from the older vines and a second Premier Cru, Morey-St-Denis, La Forge du Tart, from younger vines.

In 2018, the Pinault family acquired Clos de Tart to become the fourth owners over nine centuries.

EISELE VINEYARD

First planted to vines in the 1880s, Eisele Vineyard sits in the northeast Napa Valley, just east of Calistoga at the base of the Palisades Mountain range.

Farmed organically since 1998 and biodynamically since 2000, the site has been principally dedicated to Cabernet Sauvignon for the last fifty years.

Beginning with the inaugural release bearing the Eisele name in 1971, this iconic vineyard has received consistent recognition for possessing one of the great terroirs of Napa Valley.

The vineyard produces wines with a rare combination of forthright character which invariably express the exceptional depth, elegance and longevity which are hallmarks of the Eisele Vineyard.

CHÂTEAU LE PRIEURÉ

Saint-Émilion Grand Cru Classé

In Saint-Émilion, Château Le Prieuré, a classified growth, is set on south-facing slopes on the limestone plateau. Once called Premier Cru des Cordeliers and acquired by Joseph Brisson in 1897, Château Le Prieuré has belonged to Saint-Émilion's elite classified growths since the first classification in 1955.

Its 6.24 hectare terroir is grouped around the cellars and perfectly located on south-facing slopes on the limestone plateau. Trottevieille, Troplong Mondot, and Pavie Macquin are its immediate neighbours.

It enjoys a magnificent view of the medieval village of Saint-Emilion and the Dordogne valley. The vineyard is made up of 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc.

CHÂTEAU SIAURAC

Lalande de Pomerol

In Lalande-de-Pomerol, Château Siaurac is at Néac situated on an extension of the Pomerol plateau.

With 46 hectares almost in one single block in Lalande-de-Pomerol, located on an extension of the Pomerol plateau at Néac.

Château Siaurac is the largest and one of the most emblematic estate in the appellation. It was mentioned in the 1893 edition of Féret, 'Château Siaurac is only separated from the first great growths of Pomerol by a tiny trickle of water called the Barbane'.

CHÂTEAU VRAY CROIX DE GAY

Pomerol

Château Vray Croix de Gay dates back to the end of the 19th century, when it was formed by Joseph Brisson.

The first purchase by Brisson was for the plot known as Domaine des Grands Champs and then in 1945, his daughter and son-in-law acquired the vineyard of Vray Croix de Gay joining the two vineyard. Today the largest plot is adjacent to La Fleur, 100 metres from Petrus.

The 3.67 hectare Pomerol vineyard of Château Vray Croix de Gay is situated on clay-gravel located in the far east of the appellation and enjoying a similar climate to that of St Emilion.

The predominance of gravel radiates heat from the sun whilst the evening breeze cools – the whole process facilitating early grape ripening.

The vineyard is planted with 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc.
