APPELLATION CHATEAU-GRILLET CONTROLÉE

Château-Grillet has a rich history, illustrating perfectly the passion and devotion of many generations of men and women for this exceptional terroir.

The Viognier grape reigns supreme here, giving birth to wines of great intensity, tension and minerality: Château-Grillet and Côtes-du-Rhône.

The 3.5-hectare vineyard is situated in a south-facing amphitheatre with welltrained soil offering ideal conditions for the production of great wines and the friable sub-soil allows the vine's roots to dig deep to draw on water and mineral elements.

Clos de Tart

GRAND CRU

MONOPOLE

Clos de Tart was created in 1141 by the Tart Abbey Bernardine sisters, a branch of the nearby Cistercian congregation before passing into the hands of the MareyMange family in 1791. It was granted Grand Cru classification in 1939.

The magnificent vineyard represents a single plot of land covering 7.53 hectares, the largest Grand Cru monopole in Burgundy, located on the Morey-SaintDenis terroir in the Côte de Nuits.

An ancient stone wall surrounds the vineyard which has remained intact since its creation in the 15th-century and encompasses vines which are 60 years old on average, planted on rich limestone and clay soil.

Grapes are meticulously harvested by hand and vinified in six separate lots with wines matured in 100% new oak and bottled unfiltered producing a Grand Cru from the older vines and a second Premier Cru, Morey-St-Denis, La Forge du Tart, from younger vines.

In 2018, the Pinault family acquired Clos de Tart to become the fourth owners over nine centuries.

EISELE VINEYARD

First planted to vines in the 1880s, Eisele Vineyard sits in the northeast Napa Valley, just east of Calistoga at the base of the Palisades Mountain range.

Farmed organically since 1998 and biodynamically since 2000, the site has been principally dedicated to Cabernet Sauvignon for the last fifty years.

Beginning with the inaugural release bearing the Eisele name in 1971, this iconic vineyard has received consistent recognition for possessing one of the great terroirs of Napa Valley.

The vineyard produces wines with a rare combination of forthright character which invariably express the exceptional depth, elegance and longevity which are hallmarks of the Eisele Vineyard.

CHATEAU LATOUR

Château Latour is located in the heart of the Médoc wine region, about 50 km north-west of Bordeaux, where the legend of the vineyards of Bordeaux began. The château's prime terroir, l'Enclos, overlooks the Gironde estuary: it is the river and the ocean that, over the centuries, have given the vineyard its geological complexity and, on a daily basis, ensuring a mild climate.

The 78-hectare vineyard is planted with about 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Merlot and 2% Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot; some of the vines are more than 100 years old, contributing to the magic of the wines year after year.

The oldest document mentioning Latour dates from 1331 and is an authorisation granted to Gaucelme de Castillon by Lord Pons to build a fortified tower in the parish of Saint Maubert.

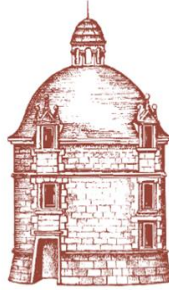

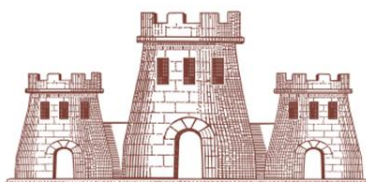


The Pauillac has been produced every year since 1989 and is primarily made from young vines, growing on the less prestigious terroirs in the vineyard, and from wines that do not meet the selection criteria for Forts de Latour (specific to each vintage).

About 20% new barrels are used in the vinification of the Pauillac, the precise proportion varying depending on the characteristics of the vintage. The blend for Château Latour's Pauillac typically consists of nearly 45% Merlot.

A creature of elegance and fruitiness, this generous wine is an excellent introduction to the wines produced by Château Latour. A real pleasure to enjoy even in its younger years and will continue to improve for several more years.

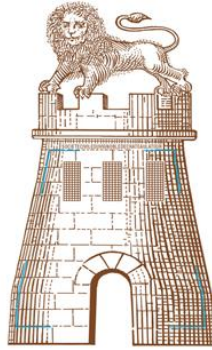


Les Forts de Latour takes its name from an historic plot in the 'Enclos'. The wine was first labelled with this name in 1966 and constant work on developing its quality has resulted in its achieving the level of a Médoc Grand Cru Classé.

Les Forts de Latour is produced with the same meticulous care and attention as the Grand Vin, both in the vineyard and in the winery. The only notable difference, apart from the origin of the grapes, offering Forts de Latour more varied characteristics and flavour profiles depending on the vintage, is the proportion of new barrels (50 to 60%) used in the maturing stage.

Château Latour's Grand Vin is made solely from old vines, in the Enclos. Gravettes, Sarmentier, Pièce de Château... these are the names of some of the finest plots that express the character of the terroir and forge the wine's identity every year.

The heart of the Enclos is the only terroir that, every year, can produce the depth, elegance and concentration expected of the Grand Vin. It is here that the Cabernet Sauvignon (accounting for more than 90% of the blend) can achieve optimal expression in terms of colour, richness and freshness.

In great vintages, the depth, concentration and complexity of Grand Vin gradually evolves resulting in a long living, increasing complex wine which is able to age for decades.
