


MEETINGS AND EVENTS IN A LANDMARK OF POWER AND PRESTIGE



THE CROMWELL ROOM

Named after Oliver Cromwell, an English military and political leader.

Private Members and Dual Members receive complimentary use of the Cromwell room for 2 hours every day, subject to availability.

Corporate Members receive complimentary use of the Cromwell room for 4 hours every day, subject to availability.

Round Table: capacity of 4





THE NEWTON ROOM

Sir Isaac Newton, an English physicist and key figure in the scientific revolution, the room feature original chandeliers and wood paneling.

Private Members and Dual Members receive complimentary use of the Newton room for 2 hours every day, subject to availability.

Corporate Members receive complimentary use of the Newton room for 4 hours every day, subject to availability.

Round Table: capacity of 7

THE WILBERFORCE ROOM

Named after William Wilberforce, an English politician, philanthropist, and a leader of the movement to abolish the slave trade.

The rooms feature original chandeliers, a marble fireplace and wood panelling.

Boardroom / Dinner: capacity of 10





THE WATT ROOM

Named after James Watt, a Scottish inventor and was fundamental in the industrial Revolution in both his native Great Britain and the rest of the world.

Whether hosting a breakfast, buffet lunch or private dinner, both rooms are perfect options.

CHAIRMAN'S LOUNGE


Originally the boardroom of the Port of London Authority, the Members Dining Room and Lounge, joined by a door between them, now a space for boardroom meetings, private dinner and receptions.

Now this historic setting provides an inspirational meeting place for both business and pleasure.

LATOUR DISCOVERY ROOM

The Château Latour Wine Room in the Club celebrates a unique relationship that has been formed between Ten Trinity Square and the legendary Premier Grand Cru Classé in Pauillac, in the Médoc north of Bordeaux. This is a place where Club members will be able to experience great wines specially shipped directly from the Château Latour as well as from other estates.

The Château Latour Discovery is a fitting room with original features, including oak panelling and carvings of influential figures in history, reflect the British location, while the atmospheric lighting is designed in homage to the cellars of the Chateau Latour estate in Bordeaux France.
