C H A M P A G N E JACQUESSON

MAISON FONDÉE EN 1798

Champagne Jacquesson, was first created in 1798, then taken over by the Chiquet family in 1974 and acquired by Artémis Domaines in December 2022.

Jacquesson harmoniously combines tradition and modernity. Located in the village of Dizy in the Vallée de la Marne, Champagne Jacquesson is a few kilometres north of Epernay. Jaquesson's vineyards are in the Grand Cru villages of Aÿ, Avize, and Oiry and the Premier Cru villages of Dizy, Mareuil-sur-Aÿ, and Hautvilliers.

Rooted in the Champagne landscape for more than 200 years, the House has opted for a bold and innovative approach through the creation of the 700s cuvées, which show vintage character, as well as four vintage champagne which highlight exceptional parcels that are only produced in the best years.

Production, deliberately limited to 300,000 bottles, bears witness to the desire to preserve uncompromising viticulture and vinification processes, which result in the remarkable quality of its wines every year.

THE GROWER CHAMPAGNE

When thinking of Champagne - world renowned names like Bollinger, Laurent Perrier and Pol Roger come to mind. These 'Grand marque' or 'Houses', produce millions of bottles with a distinctive 'House style' each year. They achieve that by creating Cuvées (blends) of different vintages and different base wines from all corners of the vast Champagne region. Because these big producers only own a fraction of vineyards, they buy grapes and wines from thousands of small grape growers in dozens of villages to meet the demand.

In the last decades we saw a rise of Champagnes made by grape growers who used to sell their grapes to the big houses. Instead of selling the grapes, these families and individuals now make champagne from their own land with their own hands. These small-batch Grower Champagnes focus on their own terroir and skills, resulting in an offering that is both a charismatic and unique expression of Champagne with amazing value.

The Domaine d'Eugénie was born from the purchase of Domaine René Egel by Francois Pinault in 2006. Traditionally the precious vineyards in the Côte d'Or only change ownership through inheritance or marriage. So on the occasion of a vineyard being sold, was "the talk of the town" in the world of wine. In 2012, Francois Pinault added to his Burgundy holdings at Domaine d'Eugénie by acquiring just less than one tenth of an acre of Montrachet and 0.12 acres of Bâtard-Montrachet.

CHATEAU~GRILLET

APPELLATION CHATEAU-GRILLET CONTROLÉE

In the heart of the Rhone valley is the iconic Château-Grillet - one of the smallest and most prestigious French appellations historically producing only white wine, and this is famed over centuries as one of the greatest.

Château-Grillet has a rich history, illustrating perfectly the passion and devotion of many generations of men and women for this exceptional terroir.

From the beginning of the 19th Century, the wines of Château-Grillet were already present in the greatest cellars of the day. Evidence of their fame comes from the collectors such as Thomas Jefferson Empress Joséphine de Beauharnais, first wife of Napoleon I and James Christie who bought bottles of Château-Grillet on behalf of King George IV of England.

The property remained with the Neyret-Gachet family from 1827 to 2011, passing from one generation to the next. During this rich period, one key date was to leave an indelible mark: on 11 December 1936, Château-Grillet succeeded in obtaining appellation contrôlée status, it was therefore one of the first French appellations and also one of the smallest. Even rarer, Château-Grillet is also a monopoly, an appellation with only one producer. This was recognition of the excellence of the terroir and of the wines it produces.

The property was acquired in June 2011 by François Pinault. Since the change of ownership, priority has been given by the team to doing everything necessary to glorify this unique viticultural heritage and to better understand the complexities of each parcel. Magnificent but demanding, the vineyard requires meticulous attention and a lot of patience.

The Viognier grape reigns supreme here, giving birth to wines of great intensity, tension and minerality: Château-Grillet and Côtes-du-Rhône.

The 3.5-hectare vineyard is situated in a south-facing Amphitheatre with well-trained soil offering ideal conditions for the production of great wines and the friable sub-soil allows the vine's roots to dig deep to draw on water and mineral elements.

PONTCIN, CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE BY CHÂTEAU-GRILLET

As from the 2011 vintage onward, the technical team decided on an even stricter selection for the wines going into the Château-Grillet blend. Analysis and comparative tasting of the different parcels showed that certain wines have not yet achieved the high level required for Château-Grillet.

By separating the grapes from the younger vines and lower terraced vineyards, an excellent Côtes-du-Rhône was created, made entirely from Viognier, which has much to offer and is a fruit forwardand elegant introduction into the wines of Château-Grillet.

This wine was originally named 'Pontcin', a reference to a place name found on the land register of the property and since 2013 has been known as 'Côtes-du-Rhône'.

CONDRIEU BY CHÂTEAU-GRILLET

In 2013 and again in 2017, we acquired a few acres of vines in the Condrieu appellation adjacent to the historical boundaries of Château-Grillet. This gave us two plots with 12 drystone terraces, known as "chaillées" in the region, that perfectly fit in with patchwork of plots that make up the estate. They cover less than 0.25 hectare and their high-quality terroir is home to vines that are around 20 years old.

The largest plot (17 acres) is situated in "La Carthery", hence the name of this wine. The soil is naturally quite similar to that of Château-Grillet's plots and vinification methods follow the same philosophy. However, the maturation process is much shorter than Château Grillet, giving a wine which unveils a different expression of Viognier's aromatic complexity and can be enjoyed in its youth.

CHÂTEAU-GRILLET

Château-Grillet is a wine for the initiated, which does not give up its secrets easily; it has great elegance, magnificent aromatic complexity and is nicely offset by the excellent acidity. It is a wine for laying down and requires patience until it reveals all its magic.

CHATEAU LATOUR

Château Latour is located in the heart of the Médoc wine region, about 50 km northwest of Bordeaux, where the legend of the vineyards of Bordeaux began. The château's prime terroir, l'Enclos, overlooks the Gironde estuary: it is the river and the ocean that, over the centuries, have given the vineyard its geological complexity and, on a daily basis, ensuring a mild climate.

The 78-hectare vineyard is planted with about 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Merlot and 2% Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot; some of the vines are more than 100 years old, contributing to the magic of the wines year after year.

The oldest document mentioning Latour dates from 1331 and is an authorisation granted to Gaucelme de Castillon by Lord Pons to build a fortified tower in the parish of Saint Maubert.

Latour was then a jointly held lord's domain until the end of the 16th century, whose co-owners received rents from the farmers who cultivated the land. At that time, the property was not entirely covered by vines and yet production largely exceeded requirements.

As a result of successive marriages and inheritances, by the 18th Century, Château Latour became the property of Alexandre de Ségur 'Prince of Vines', who quickly acquired a considerable collection of properties in the Médoc. The château's real wine history began with the arrival of this family.

Very quickly, the wines of the best estates, including Château Latour, stood out in terms of quality and price. In 1714, a barrel of Latour was worth four to five times more than a barrel of typical Bordeaux wine. By 1729, the ratio had risen to thirteen and by 1767 to twenty. Recognition of Château Latour was already very wellestablished. The property thus benefited from a quite exceptional location and the unique terroir was given 'first growth' or 'premier cru' ranking in the official 1855 classification of the Haut Médoc.

This unique heritage shows us an extraordinary stability and continuity in the life of the property and those who have worked there during its long history, which has no doubt been an important factor in the exceptional regularity and quality of the wines; In the official 1855 classification, Château Latour was given a 'Premier Cru' rating brining with is worldwide recognition.



The Pauillac has been produced every year since 1989 and is primarily made from young vines, growing on the less prestigious terroirs in the vineyard, and from wines that do not meet the selection criteria for Forts de Latour (specific to each vintage).

About 20% new barrels are used in the vinification of the Pauillac, the precise proportion varying depending on the characteristics of the vintage. The blend for Château Latour's Pauillac typically consists of nearly 45% Merlot.

A creature of elegance and fruitiness, this generous wine is an excellent introduction to the wines produced by Château Latour. A real pleasure to enjoy even in its younger years and will continue to improve for several more years.

Les Forts de Latour takes its name from an historic plot in the 'Enclos'. The wine was first labelled with this name in 1966 and constant work on developing its quality has resulted in its achieving the level of a Médoc Grand Cru Classé.

Les Forts de Latour is produced with the same meticulous care and attention as the Grand Vin, both in the vineyard and in the winery. The only notable difference, apart from the origin of the grapes, offering Forts de Latour more varied characteristics and flavour profiles depending on the vintage, is the proportion of new barrels (50 to 60%) used in the maturing stage.

Château Latour's Grand Vin is made solely from old vines, in the Enclos. Gravettes, Sarmentier, Pièce de Château... these are the names of some of the finest plots that express the character of the terroir and forge the wine's identity every year.

The heart of the Enclos is the only terroir that, every year, can produce the depth, elegance and concentration expected of the Grand Vin. It is here that the Cabernet Sauvignon (accounting for more than 90% of the blend) can achieve optimal expression in terms of colour, richness and freshness.

In great vintages, the depth, concentration and complexity of Grand Vin gradually evolves resulting in a long living, increasing complex wine which is able to age for decades.

MONOPOLE

Clos de Tart was created in 1141 by the Tart Abbey Bernardine sisters, a branch of the nearby Cistercian congregation before passing into the hands of the Marey-Mange family in 1791. It was granted Grand Cru classification in 1939.

The magnificent vineyard represents a single plot of land covering 7.53 hectares, the largest Grand Cru monopole in Burgundy, located on the Morey-Saint-Denis terroir in the Côte de Nuits.

An ancient stone wall surrounds the vineyard which has remained intact since its creation in the 15th-century and encompasses vines which are 60 years old on average, planted on rich limestone and clay soil.

Grapes are meticulously harvested by hand and vinified in six separate lots with wines matured in 100% new oak and bottled unfiltered producing a Grand Cru from the older vines and a second Premier Cru, Morey-Saint-Denis, La Forge du Tart, from younger vines.

In 2018, the Pinault family acquired Clos de Tart to become the fourth owners over nine centuries.

THE AMERICANS



First planted to vines in the 1880s, Eisele Vineyard sits in the northeast Napa Valley, just east of Calistoga at the base of the Palisades Mountain range. Farmed organically since 1998 and biodynamically since 2000, the site has been principally dedicated to Cabernet Sauvignon for the last fifty years. Beginning with the inaugural release bearing the Eisele name in 1971, this iconic vineyard has received consistent recognition for possessing one of the great terroirs of Napa Valley.

The vineyard produces wines with a rare combination of forthright character which invariably express the exceptional depth, elegance and longevity which are hallmarks of the Eisele Vineyard.

The history of Eisele Vineyard dates back to the 1880s when the first vines were planted, yielding Zinfandel and Riesling varietals. In 1969, Milton and Barbara Eisele, who gave their name to the vineyard, decided to produce a high-end wine with Cabernet Sauvignon.

In 1990 Daphne and Bart Araujo bought the celebrated land that had nurtured some of the earliest grapes in Napa Valley. they produced outstanding wines, exquisite Cabernet Sauvignons that secured a world-class reputation for the Eisele Vineyard and created a touchstone for Napa Valley.

The Eisele vineyard was bought by Artémis in 2013 and today 75% of the vineyard is planted with Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Merlot (all of which are used to form their flagship Cabernet Sauvignon) with smaller blocks of Sauvignon Blanc.
